

Provider Script to Capture Patient's Consent to Share Behavioral Health Data

I would like to tell you about our partnership with CRISP, the designated Health Information Exchange for DC. The Health Information Exchange, or HIE, helps us coordinate care with other members of your healthcare team.

We would like to ask for your permission to have your behavioral health data information available to other members of your care team. They can login to CRISP's secure DC Portal to view important information about your care. This information includes:

- Clinical behavioral health data protected by 42 CFR Part 2 (a federal rule around sharing information), including substance use disorder (SUD) treatment information
- Contact information for any of your SUD treatment providers

CRISP is a secure network and only your providers have access to this information about your health. By agreeing to participate, you can help all members of your care team see a more detailed picture of your health. Your participation can also save on healthcare costs to both you and your provider. You are always in control of your consent. Your consent expires in one year (or later, if desired) and you may choose to opt-out at any time.
