

Advance Care Planning Documents: Viewing within CRISP DC HIE

Advance Care Planning in the District

Advance care planning documents that have been created or uploaded to the A|D Vault Exchange are made viewable within the CRISP DC HIE. Providers can create or upload documents using the embedded version of MyDirectives for Clinicians embedded in the CRISP DC HIE. Patients are also able to use A|D Vault's public facing patient portal at MyDirectives.com to create or upload advance care planning documents on their own.

Regardless of your organization's use of A|D Vault's tools, all CRISP users can view, download, and print advance care planning documents in the CRISP DC HIE. Below is a quick guide of how to view the documents within the HIE.

Care Coordination

First, select the Clinical Information application. Next, select the Care Coordination menu option. After navigating to Care Coordination, CRISP users will see two tabs: Care Team and Advance Directives. Select the Advance Directives tab. Users will see details about when the form was submitted, the source of the form (A|D Vault for DC), the document type and effective date. By clicking on the folder icon, users can view the full document.
