

## FAQs for Care Team Members

### 1. What is the CRISP DC Consent Tool?

- The CRISP DC Consent Tool is a comprehensive consent management tool that enables the electronic exchange of a patient's substance use disorder (SUD) data that is protected by 42 CFR Part 2. Based on the patient's data sharing preferences, information about their SUD treatment may be shared with other members of their care team.
  - Patients can choose to share all their clinical SUD data with the HIE, or they can choose to share ONLY their care teams' contact information.

### 2. Who can register a consent for a patient?

- Any member of the patient's care team can register a consent; this includes but is not limited to:
  - Social Workers
  - Care Coordinators
  - Nurses
  - Case Managers
  - Part 2 Providers
  - Primary Care Physicians

### 3. Why should I use the CRISP DC Consent Tool?

- Members of a patient's care team can utilize the consent tool to allow a patient's sensitive data protected by 42 CFR Part 2 regulations to be shared with other members of their care team. This can allow for care team members to get a more holistic picture of a patient's health record and can assist with the coordination of care between different providers.

### 4. How will I fit the CRISP DC Consent Tool into my workflow?
