

Opt-out Form Now Available in the Consent Tool

CRISP DC users can now complete an **HIE Opt-out form** with their patients through the CRISP DC Consent Tool. This new functionality allows providers to seamlessly conduct a patient opt-out within the HIE.

What is an HIE Opt-out form?

The HIE opt-out form allows patients to opt-out of participating in the District of Columbia's statewide Health Information Exchange (HIE). The District of Columbia is an opt-out state, meaning that patients are automatically opted into having their healthcare data shared through the HIE from participating organizations, unless they explicitly opt-out.

Previously only available by going directly to the CRISP DC website, providers can now conveniently launch the form on the website from the Consent Tool.

How does it work?

Patients who wish to no longer have their healthcare data shared with other members of their care team, through the DC HIE, should complete this form.

How can I access the form?

CRISP DC users can access the opt-out form by searching for the patient who wishes to opt-out, navigating to the Consent Tool in the **CRISP InContext App or web-based DC Portal**, and selecting the HIE Opt-Out form. Clicking into the form will launch the form in a new window, which can be filled out and submitted via the [CRISP DC website](http://www.crispdc.org).

HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE PATIENT OPT-OUT FORM

This form is to be used by patients who do not wish to participate in the District of Columbia's statewide Health Information Exchange (HIE).

A Health Information Exchange, or HIE, is a way of sharing your health information among participating doctors' offices, hospitals, care coordinators, labs, radiology centers, and other health care providers through secure, electronic means. The purpose is so that each of your participating healthcare providers can have the benefit of the most recent information available from your other participating providers when taking care of you. When you opt out of participation in the HIE, doctors and nurses will not be able to search for your health information through the HIE to use while treating you. Your physician or other treating providers will still be able to select the HIE as a way to receive your lab results, radiology reports, and other data sent directly to them that they may have previously received by fax, mail, or other electronic communications. Additionally, in accordance with the law, Public health reporting, such as the reporting of infectious diseases to public health officials, will still occur through the HIE after you decide to opt out. Controlled Dangerous Substances (CDS) information, as part of the DC Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, will continue to be available through the HIE to licensed providers.

This opt-out form only needs to be completed once to opt out of the HIE; it is not necessary to complete for each provider. If you do not live in the District of Columbia, but still receive care in the region, you should complete this form to opt out. If you wish to reverse your decision, you may opt back in at any time by calling CRISP DC at 1.877.952.7477.

Please be advised that opting out does not preclude any participating organization that has received or accessed PHI via the HIE prior to such opt-out, and incorporated such PHI into its records, from retaining such information in its records.
