


HIPAA Authorization Form

CRISP DC is excited to launch a new form within the CRISP DC Consent Tool to allow patients to consent to share their clinical data with non-HIPAA-covered providers!

What is the HIPAA Authorization form?

The HIPAA Authorization form is a form to be completed by a **HIPAA-covered provider** to release the patient's HIPAA-covered data (clinical data, medications, labs, and social needs data) to a non-HIPAA-covered provider like a **community-based organization (CBO)** that is providing treatment to the patient to address a need.



Where can I access the HIPAA Authorization form?

The HIPAA Authorization form is available in the **CRISP DC Consent Tool**. Within the tool, you'll find a list of various forms. Select the **HIPAA Authorization** form to complete it on the patient's behalf.

Who can access the HIPAA Authorization form?

Any HIPAA-covered provider that is onboarded to use the CRISP DC platform can use the HIPAA authorization form.

As a HIPAA-covered provider, how do I use the HIPAA Authorization form?

1. Make sure that you have access to the CRISP DC Consent Tool
2. Consult with your patients if they want their HIPAA-covered data shared with non-HIPAA-covered entities
3. Begin submitting HIPAA authorization forms for your patients

I am a CBO, and I want to see my patients' HIPAA-covered data to help provide them with care. What do I need to do?

1. Reach out to CRISP DC to get onboarded and complete the required paperwork
2. Begin submitting patient panels through the panel processor tile
3. Search for patients within CRISP DC that have a HIPAA authorization on file
4. See patients' clinical data to provide them with better care
